BATTLING EVIL ALTARS

The battle against Kenya is a battle against her destiny, in this same way the Mt. Kenya County battles target it's Destiny. Every spiritual battle is a battle of altars. This is why we're now seeing a rise of old evil altars. Let us deal with the altars listed here:

a. Ancestral Worship

Judges 6:25-28. God challenged Gideon to destroy the altar of Baal in his father's house before he could move into his destiny. Silence the voice of Mukurwe Wa Nyagathanga, Ngai wa Kirinyaga and every ritual of Elders and Njuri Ncheke to empower them.

b. Tribalism

This is one of the biggest ills ailing us, especially politically. In 1 Kings 12:25-33, Jeroboam devised his own priestly order and built two unauthorized altars in his territory to secure the political allegiance of the 10 Northern tribes of Israel. It is the same today. Pray according to 1 Kings 13:1-3, that God would raise a "Josiah" that will destroy these altars and restore the Region back to God.

c. Death

Gen 4:10-12. Innocent blood always cries out for vengeance. It provides a legality for a curse to come upon the land. There've been too many cases of murders in these counties and suicides, infants aborted, ritual killings, even killing of goats and other animals to appease the dead and other forms of necromancy.

Repent for the perpetration of these evils in the land and destroy the altars sustaining them.

d. Idolatry and Witchcraft

Pray against the power of witchcraft (control, manipulation, curses) in government, business, rural areas and homes.

Ask God to forgive us for idolatry or the worship of other gods both 'local' and 'imported' idolatry 2 Kings 16:10-13. Pray according to Zech. 1:18-21 for God to send His craftsmen angels to demolish these altars.

e. Corruption

Repent of and renounce the idol of covetousness or greed and ask God to cleanse the Church of this sin (Colossians 3:5).

Like Gideon, pray that God will use you to destroy the works of idolatry, corruption, ancestral worship (necromancy) and witchcraft in your family and neighbourhood for Jesus to reign. (Judges 6:25-28)

Declare the Fulfillment of Prophetic Words

1 Tim 1:18 teaches us what to do with prophetic words. They don't necessarily come to pass on their own. We are to use them to wage a good warfare to see the fulfillment of what God has promised.

God has given our nation many prophetic words, some as warnings and many as promises.

Pray that prophetic warnings of the Lord will be heeded, and declare the coming to pass of God's prophetic promises, in particular that Kenya is a Father nation, that it shall be a springboard of revival, and also that it shall be a Lighthouse unto the nations of Africa.

Revival

Ps. 85:6 is a cry to God, asking Him to revive us again that we may rejoice in Him. Revival is the hope of our nation. It is a promise from God. It is the season for it now! Let's call upon God for it. Pray for:

a. A revival of intimacy with the Holy Spirit in the lives of individual believers.

b. A genuine conviction by the Holy Spirit that causes men to truly turn away from sin and iniquity and turn to God in brokenness and surrender.

c. Unity and oneness in the body of Christ in this nation, that there'll be a genuine bond of brotherhood in the church in Kenya

d. An unprecedented harvest of souls.

e. A renewed passion for disciple-making.

“Declare: Central Kenya Counties shall experience the Supertural Move of God in 2024”

Youthful energy, creativity, and mission-mindedness are needed for the church to realize its potential and perpetuate the apostolic message. This energy must be directed constructively, by seeking God, lest the enemy turn youthful energy into a negative, destructive force.

Pray that youth would...

Commit their lives to Christ, be filled with His Spirit, be baptized in His name and fully submitted to divine authority.

Develop an abiding, personal relationship with Christ John 15:5

Know who they are, what they have in Christ, and what they can do through Him, not by the standards of the world. Colossians 1:27, Ephesians 1:4, 7, 11-14

- Develop the strength of character to remain morally pure in this permissive society. Psalm 51:7-10:

Make right decisions about sex, drugs, and worldly pleasures. Their only true safety is abstinence. Defeat negative peer pressure and pursue the God of the Bible.

Retain values that have shall make the region, nation and churches great, by biblical principles of integrity, honesty and be true in relationships that glorify God Titus 2:11-14, Psalm 119:63; John 15:13-14

- That teens will not yield to the prevailing world view culture, peer pressure, but will stand firm against sexual, social temptations and the Holy Spirit will convict them of sin, lead them in righteousness and pursue accountability. 1 Corinthians 10:13

- Pray that youth would be Mission minded Mark 16:15-16 and become agents for revival in their churches, schools, communities and accept roles of responsibility in these areas; to live for God in this ungodly world, taking their place in God's kingdom
